I have been involved in Rottweilers for the past 43 years. I got my first rott from the famous Janbicca kennels in England. Jane Bloom was the owner and she bred some of the nicest dogs at that time. The first dog I got died from cancer at a young age. I got another one from her called Janbicca Perseus who was a son of the famous Chesera Dark Charles. He became an Irish Champion and sired champions. The first time I saw a rott was a summer camp at a R.A.F camp outside Blackpool when I was on trial with Manchester United F.C. I was 17 at the time. I have bred a dog called Kanesbrook Black Denzil. He won 22 CCs 7 CCs was a GB & Irish Champion Top winning dog 2006 2007 BOB at Crufts 2007 from over 300 plus dogs. He was top show dog all breeds in Ireland in 2008. He also won a prestige event in England DOG of the YEAR 2007 & 2008. I have also bred another BOB at Crufts. I don't show as much now as old age has caught up with me and I can not get around the ring now. I love judging going to different countries to see the different breeds and meeting the people.

I'm looking forward to judge at this very important Dogshow.

My parents already had a well-known Boxerkennel before I was born. Thus I grew up with Boxers and as a child I accompanied my parents to all the dogshows in Europe. My mother and I bred many Boxerlitters with very good results.

My late husband owned Dobermanns and black Miniature Schnauzers, so when we got married, we owned 1 Dobermann and 2 Boxers.

My first judge-examination was for Boxers. I am now approved to judge all breeds in FCI-Group 1 and 2 and some breeds in Group 3, 5 and 9. I've judged in nearly every European country and in Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Indonesia, Israel, Malaysia, New Zealand, Peru, Singapore, South –Africa and U.S.A. (including several World Winner Shows and European Winner Shows). I judge about 35 times a year with great pleasure.

In the last 25 years I was a committee member of the Dutch Judges Club. Now I am an honorary member.
